Note about exchanges within a twinning:

As far as possible those taking part in exchanges should pay for their own travel and provide reciprocal hospitality.

Activities and exchanges possible within a twinning:

Ideas given in the Twinning handbook include the following;

- 1) Schools and colleges - School children and students can be put in contact with each other to correspond and exchange information. Schools can be linked and exchange visits organized.
- 2) Youth - may be sporting, cultural or work-related.
- 3) Fairs and festivals - for example the handbook suggests visits of cultural and sports groups for competitions or displays, local band etc...
- 4) Work and industry - including exchange programmes between employees.
- 5) Other community exchanges - A twinning should embrace the whole community and the less fortunate members should be given an opportunity to participate. Many family to family exchanges, short visits of mixed groups or even group holidays can take place within twinings. Other groups may include women's organisations, churches, local media etc...

The twinning handbook emphasises that there is no end to the possibilities and with a little imagination this list can be considerably extended - so send us your ideas and get involved !!!
